Why Summer Camp

For over 4 decades we have held Summer camp programs for students. Providing a safe place for students to experience one of the best weeks of their life!

What should I expect at camp?

Exciting Worship, Relevant Speaking, God Moments, Sports, Swimming, Quality Food, Camp Competitions, Creative Activities and a safe place to be yourself and establish relationships that will last a lifetime.

Purpose:

- 1. Provide a place for students to Discover God, Impact Journeys & Inspire Others.
- 2. Provide a place for healthy, life-giving relationships to be formed.

Camp Registration Checklist:

- 1. Make sure each registration form is filled out in its entirety (either paper form or online).
- 2. If a student has any medications/allergies make sure a medication administration form is filled out and included.
- 3. Early registrations must be postmarked or completed online by June 1st (with \$50 deposit) to receive discount.
- 4. All Staff Applications need to be returned by July 1st so a background check can be completed.

Summer Camp FAQ

Registration Information

How do I register for summer camp?

Turn in your completed application and your registration fee. The application must be completed by the camper's legal guardian. ****Early bird pricing is available (before June 1st) and is secured by submitting an application & a \$50 deposit by June 1st***

When is my students camp & how much does it cost?

Camp IMPACT (grades 6-12) July 11-15 | \$150 (\$50 deposit by June 1st) | \$175 (after)

Camp ADVENTURE (grades K-5) July 15-18 | \$150 (\$50 deposit by June 1st) | \$175 (after)

Can my student attend a camp that's not for their grade?

Grades are based off of the school year just completed, however we do give the option for those getting ready to enter 6th grade to move up to Senior Camp if they would like to.

Arrival and Departure

Where is camp located?

Camp Maranatha: 5847 Oak Grove Pl, Dublin, VA 24084.

What time is check-in and check-out?

Individual campers and groups should plan to arrive between 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. on the start date of their camp. No one is allowed to check-in before 2 PM!

Check-out time is at 10:00 a.m. on the last day of each camp. Campers must be picked up by their parent/legal guardian or their designated group/on-site leader.

Accommodations

Housing Accommodations

All campers will be staying in a dorm room holding 10-15 students. The dorms are equipped with bunk beds and have a/c. Sleeping bags are recommended for bedding and a twin fitted sheet to cover the mattress. Showers and restrooms are located down the hall inside the dorms.

Supervision

Who is on staff during camp?

The camp is staffed with a camp director & residential team, food service personnel, counselors, and a medical team. Special precautions are taken during water activities and certified lifeguards are on duty.

Are campers always supervised?

Yes – A counselor accompanies campers at children’s camp 24 hours a day.

How do you pick your counselors?

Along with checking two personal references and one pastoral reference, each applicant is carefully screened and hand-picked by the Camp Director. Every counselor must pass a background check.

Phone Calls, Mail, and Visitors

May I call my camper?

We are fully aware of our great responsibility in the care of your child. In case of an emergency, you will be notified immediately. Out of consideration for other campers and planned activities, incoming calls are not allowed except in case of emergency. Should campers need to contact parents, calls can be made through the camp office.

Can I reach someone at camp any time of the day or night in case of an emergency?

Yes – The emergency number is (540) 674-5885.

What do you do for homesick campers? Do you let them call home?

Yes – Campers are allowed to call home. Campers who become homesick and leave their camp session early are not eligible for refunds.

Can campers receive mail during their stay?

No.

Are visitors allowed to come?

We observe a closed campus policy for all of our camps. We do allow visitors & parents the last night of each camp & it is mandatory that upon your arrival you check-in with the camp director, or the camp’s head counselors.

Is there a designated time for parents to visit?

Yes! The last night/service of camp, all parents are encouraged to join us for a powerful, life-changing service. This is your sneak peak of what camp life is like, so come be a part!

Adult Counselors/Volunteers

Can adult Counselors/Volunteers do activities with campers?

Yes – Counselors/Volunteers can participate in activities with the campers, but are not required to do so.

How much does it cost for a Counselors/Volunteers to attend?

Counselors are required to turn in a staff application by July 1st.

Where do counselors stay?

Counselors/Volunteers are housed in the boys/girls dorms with the students.

Do you require a background check on adults?

Yes – Counselors/Volunteers 18 years or older must have a background check approved by the Registration Office, no exceptions.

Medical Information

Is there a nurse available at all times?

Yes – Nurses are on staff 24 hours a day.

Which medications should my child bring to camp?

Prescription medications should be in the original bottle with only the amount needed for the camper's length of stay at camp. All prescription bottles should come in a Ziploc bag with a completed Camp Medication Form. All inhalers, nasal sprays, and epi-pens must be in the prescription box with label and must NOT be expired. No over-the-counter medications should be brought to camp.

Do you give kids pain reliever if needed?

Yes – Designated medical staff is available at the Nurses' Station to dispense over-the-counter medication as needed. You need to give approval on the Camper Application if you would like the medical staff to give your child Tylenol.

Does my child have to turn in his medicine even if he knows when to take it and how much?

Campers are allowed to bring prescription medications, but these must be turned in to the nurse at check-in (this includes inhalers).

Are washing machines available for campers that wet the bed?

Yes - There are washing machines available for campers that wet the bed.

What is your Lice Policy?

We ask that you have a thorough head check for each camper and staff member before leaving your church. We have a no nit policy. Upon arrival, all students and staff will be checked. If there's discovery, the leader will be responsible for returning the individual home.

Special Accommodations

Can my camper just attend during the day?

We are fully aware that many young children have difficulty with overnight stays away from home. While our camp program is designed for students to check-in at the beginning of camp and check-out at the end, we do make some accommodations for children to check-out each night with their parent/guardian and return the next morning. This option is only available for Camp Adventure (K-5th).

Worship Services

How many times a day do you have services?

We have nightly services, and devotions every morning.

Spending Money

How much money do they need to bring?

We recommend \$20-25, for daily snacks, and/or camp merch.

Do campers keep their own money at camp?

We recommend that all campers deposit their money into an account for the snack shack. All transactions will be made through this account and the remaining balance will be returned to your child at the end of camp (***this is mandatory for camp adventure***). Please note that if your student decides to keep their own money, no refunds will be given for money that is stolen or missing.

Misc.

Refund Policy

No refunds will be issued for any camps.

Items NOT To Bring

- No cell phones or electronic games

- No alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products*
- No knives of any kind*
- No firearms or fireworks*
- No over-the-counter medication*

*Campers bringing these items into camp will be immediately dismissed.

Rules Page

Rules Page

All campers shall be responsible to all rules while attending camp. Failure to adhere to camp rules will result in a review by the camp staff and possible dismissal.

1. All campers shall pay the registration fee. No refunds shall be given except in cases of sickness or emergency.
2. Every student/adult on the premises must be registered as a camper or worker. No student can work his/her designated camp. No exceptions.
3. We should strive at ALL times to conduct ourselves as Christian Gentlemen & Ladies, with proper consideration to each other. This includes NO P.D.A (Public Display of Affection) and profanity is not allowed.
4. Campers are not allowed to leave the campground after checking in. Any camper that drives his/her own vehicle will turn in their keys to the camp director upon arrival.
5. Campers are not allowed to enter the residence of the opposite sex.
6. The daily schedule must be observed by all. Attendance at all camp activities is required and expected of all campers unless granted permission by the Camp Director.
7. No campers are allowed in the cabins.
8. Shoes must be worn at all times outside of the dorm rooms.
9. Campers will follow the directions of their counselors and all camp staff.
10. No tobacco, alcohol, or over-the-counter drugs are allowed or brought on campgrounds at anytime.
11. All medication must be checked in at the camp office and placed under supervision of the camp nurse.
12. No fireworks of any kind will be permitted.
13. No pocket knives or any other type of weapon will be allowed on campgrounds.
14. Any money brought to camp and NOT turned into the snack shack is your responsibility. New Hope Church will NOT refund any money that is stolen!

15. Cell phones/ipods/electronic devices are NOT ALLOWED and will be confiscated at check in. Families can contact the Camp Director in case of an emergency or your youth pastor/ church pastor if needed.
16. Any destruction of camp property will result in immediate removal from campgrounds and no refund will be granted.
17. No hazing, bullying, or pranking will be tolerated and can result in the removal of camp with no refund granted.
18. Campers must stay with their counselor/team leader at all times. Campers found or reported unattended can result in the removal of camp with no refund granted. Camper safety is our first priority.
19. THERE WILL BE A HEAD CHECK FOR ALL CAMPERS UPON ARRIVAL. WE APOLOGIZE FOR ANY INCONVENIENCE AND RECOMMEND A CHECK AT YOUR HOME CHURCH BEFORE DEPARTURE. IN THE EVENT OF DISCOVERY ON OUR CAMPUS WE WILL HAVE TO ASK THE GROUP LEADER TO TAKE THE STUDENT HOME. WE HAVE NO FLEXIBILITY ON THE MATTER.
